



A Picture of American Generosity


2022 Contributions:

Giving to Religion: Declining Share




Giving by type of recipient as a percentage of the total in five-year spans, 1983-2022*


(adjusts for inflation, 2022 = \$100, does not include "unallocated" or "giving to individuals")


Changing Support for UCC Congregations

% of UCC Cong Exp covered by Individual Giving






Increased stress about money in congregations


How will the fragility of congregations affect the formation of new agencies?

(Share of Americans giving to charity 68% in 2002 → 55% in 2014



